Admission to the Health Pavilion

While a resident at Oak Hammock, you may have the need to be admitted to the Health Pavilion. To be admitted, a physician must provide a written order on approved State of Florida forms. Admissions can be processed 24/7. An admission exception can be made for residents who have been seen by a UF Health physician within the past six months, since their medical information will be available on the EPIC computer system. Additional information regarding admission to the Health Pavilion may be obtained from the Social Services Liaison at (352) 548-1152 or Admissions and Marketing Coordinator for the Health Pavilion at (352) 548-1133.

For Independent Living residents who are patients at UF Health and have been seen there within the past six months and need admission to skilled nursing, read-only access to UF electronic records is available and an order for admission is not immediately necessary. Staff will verify that there have been no medication or condition changes and additional information may be necessary. For patients at North Florida Regional, the VAMC, or any other medical system that has not granted Oak Hammock access to their electronic medical records, hard copies of this information is required at the time of admission (form 3008)
