Admission to Skilled Nursing - After hours

Oak Hammock will welcome its contract holders to skilled nursing on nights and weekends. Because of our licensure we require certain information including current medical records before or at the time of admission in order to safely care for our residents.

If you are a patient at UF Health and you need admission to skilled nursing, we have read-only access to your UF Health electronic medical records. We will of course verify with you that there have been no medication or condition changes and may have to obtain some additional information, additional labs, etc.

If you are a patient at North Florida Regional, the VAMC, or any other medical system that has not granted us access to their electronic medical records, we will need hard copies of this information at the time of your admission. The 3008 form, which all providers are familiar with, is a good outline of the information we require although we do not require the information on that particular form.

We recommend that all contract holders review their advance directives to be sure that their most recent documents are on file at Oak Hammock so that if you do become a patient and we need to contact your health care surrogate, we can easily locate them. Please bring your most recent documents either to the Primary Care Medical Clinic reception desk (if you are a UF Health patient) so that the receptionist can scan the documents in to your UF Health electronic medical records or take to the Resident Liaison or Assisted Living Social Worker if you are a patient of another medical system.
